Information on Tuition and Administrative Fees for the Cohort 2026/27

13.07.2026



1. Tuition Fees

The total tuition fee for the programme is **€5,000** for students from within and outside the European Higher Education Area (EHEA) covering all 4 semesters.

All tuition fees must be paid two weeks after admission to the programme. Students who do not complete payment by this deadline will not be enrolled in the programme.

2. Further Fees

No application or admission fee is charged by the consortium.¹

Upon admission, all students are required to pay an **enrolment fee** that covers the administrative costs at all five partner universities throughout the duration of the programme. The total enrolment fee amounts to **€145,25**. This fee is separate from the tuition fees, non-refundable, and may be subject to change for each cohort.

At the University of Cologne, enrolment is automatically linked to the purchase of a **Semester Ticket**, which provides unlimited travel on local and regional buses and trains throughout Germany for the entire semester. Students who are not residing permanently in Germany and therefore cannot use the *Semester Ticket* fully can apply for a refund of the ticket costs in any semester. The programme coordinator will provide individual support throughout the refund application process. The costs of the first semester are **€226,80**.

¹ Please note: Applicants need to provide a legal check of their Bachelor's degree via the German service provider uni-assist. The so-called "[Preliminary Review Documentation](#)" (abbreviated VPD) assesses the equivalency of international degrees and is mandatory for all students with a non-German Bachelor's degree to be enrolled at the University of Cologne. Applicants apply for a VPD individually via the [uni-assist website](#) and have to cover the costs of **75€** themselves.

3. Payment Overview & Schedule

All payments must be completed by the stated deadlines. Late or incomplete payments may affect enrolment status.

3. Non-Payment of Tuition Fees

Students who fail to pay the full tuition fee by the deadline will not be enrolled.

4. Withdrawal and Refund Policy

4.1 Voluntary Withdrawal

Students who choose to discontinue the programme and formally withdraw from enrolment are not eligible for any refund of tuition fees.

4.2 Withdrawal Due to Illness

Students who withdraw due to documented illness may be eligible for a partial refund of tuition fees. The percentage of the refund will be determined on a case-by-case basis.

Administrative fees are non-refundable under all circumstances.

5. Study Interruption (Pause Option)

Students may request to temporarily pause their studies due to valid reasons (e.g. illness).

Approved students may continue their studies at a later stage, as long as the programme remains available.

6. Final Provisions

By enrolling in the programme, students agree to comply with this tuition policy, including all payment obligations and conditions related to withdrawal, refunds, and study interruptions.
